States are encouraged to recognize DAR members who give of their time and expertise to 1.) communicate the current standards to verify new and supplemental applications and 2.) provide direct assistance to chapters in need with the Outstanding Volunteer Genealogist Award.

A nominee for Outstanding Volunteer Genealogist should be nominated by her chapter or unit overseas and must be a member in good standing of the National Society. She should exhibit outstanding work in the following areas:

- Knowledge of current standards used by the Genealogy Department for evaluating an application or supplemental application.
- Willingness to communicate the current standards to others
- Ability and interest in working with prospective members
- Willingness to assist other chapters with their membership goals
- Willingness to continue her training with updated Volunteer Genealogy training

State recipients of the Outstanding Volunteer Genealogist Award are eligible to purchase the Outstanding Volunteer Genealogist Pin. It is the responsibility of the winners to prove eligibility by providing a copy of the winner's certificate or other documentation to the Office of the Organizing Secretary General.
